Asymmetrical collar-Cape

This work is very inspired tartan, I wanted to cross the scratches with the yarn itself and contrast obtained by moss strips and stockinette st.

One Size (S to M)

<u>Material:</u>

Circular needles 5mm with a cable of 120cm.

9 balls of Reggae Schoppel Wolle, color 6900mbre 2199, alter schwede.

Stitch marker, row counter, sew or tapestry needle.

Points and abbreviations:

st: stitch

k: knit

p: purl

m1: make 1.

K2tog: knit 2 stitches together. In this model, this is used to attach the collar perpendicular to the edge, the last stitch of the edge is knitted with the mesh of the neck that comes at the end of the row.

* ... *: Knitting pattern between * and * until end of round or round, or until the next indication.

(...) x ...: knitting pattern in parenthesis the number of times after the "x".

[...]x....: knitting pattern in brackets the number of times after the "x".

R: Round or Row

M: stitch marker

Gauge (stockinette st., 10cm/10cm): 24r/18st.

Work:

Knitting in the round:

Cast on 96 st. in long cast tail (vey flexilally, if necessary use needles 8 mm for exemple), put the stitch marker used to identify the start of the round, form the circle making sure not to twist the stitches and knit:

Part in ribs and moss stitch:

R1: *p3, k1, p1, k1*

R2: *p2, (k1, p1)x2*

Repeat these two rounds until 25 cm high. Then knit every round i to 30cm total height.

Part increases:

R1: *k8, m1* (108st)

R2, 3, 4: *k*

R5: *k9, m1* (120st)

R6, 7, 8: *k*

R9: *k10, m1* (132st)

R10, 11, 12: *k*

R13: *k6, m1* (144st)

R14, 15, 16: *k*

R17: *k7, m1*(176st)

R18, 19, 20: *k*

R21, 23, 25, 27: *k1, p1*

R22, 24, 26, 28: *p1, k1*

Cut the yarn to 40 cm long, and go to the strip which forms the body of the cape.

Perpendicular edge:

This edge is worked in straight knitting with right side and wrong side rows, for this you can keep your circular needles and use them as straight needles.

Cast on 18st on the left needle and knit:

R1, 3, 5, 7 (right side rows): (k1, p1)x8, k1, K2tog.

R2, 4, 6, 8(wrong side rows): (p1, k1)x9.

R9 and all the right side rows to row 115 included: (k1, p1)x2, m1, *k*, finish with K2tog. You have one more stitch at every right side row.

R10 and all the wrong side rows to row 116 included: *p* to the 3 last st .: k1, p1, k1.

At row 116: 72 st.

R117: (k1, p1)x2, k4, M, (p1, k1)x2, M, k59, K2tog.

R118: p60, M, (k1, p1)x2, M, p5, k1, p1, k1.

Repeat rows 117 and 118 up to row 148 included.

R149: (k1, p1)x2, k4, [M, (p1, k1)x2, M]x2, k51, K2tog.

R150: p52, [M,(k1, p1)x2, M, p4]x2, (p1, k1)x2.

Repeat rows 149 and 150 up to row 180 included.

R181: (k1, p1)x2, k4, [M, (p1, k1)x2, M]x3, k43, K2tog.

R182: p44, [M,(k1, p1)x2, M, p4]x3, (p1, k1)x2.

Repeat rows 181 and 182 up to row 212 included.

R213: (k1, p1)x2, k4, [M, (p1, k1)x2, M]x4, k35, K2tog.

R214:p36, [M,(k1, p1)x2, M, p4]x4, (p1, k1)x2.

Repeat rows 213 and 214 up to row 244 included.

R245:(k1, p1)x2, k4, [M, (p1, k1)x2, M]x5, k27, K2tog.

R246: p28, [M,(k1, p1)x2, M, p4]x5, <math>(p1, k1)x2.

Repeat rows 245 and 246 up to row 278 included.

R279:(k1, p1)x2, k4, [M, (p1, k1)x2, M]x6, k19, K2tog.

R280: p20, [M,(k1, p1)x2, M, p4]x6, <math>(p1, k1)x2.

Repeat rows 279 and 280 up to row 312 included.

R313: (k1, p1)x2, k4, [M, (p1, k1)x2, M]x7, k11, K2tog.

R314: p12, [M,(k1, p1)x2, M, p4]x7, <math>(p1, k1)x2.

Repeat rows 313 and 314 up to row 344 included.

R345: (k1, p1)x2, w1, (p1, k1)x33, p1, K2tog.(73st.)

R346, 348 and 350: (k1, p1)x36, k1.

R347, 349, 351: (k1, p1)x36, K2tog.

R352: Bind off all the st. by purling them.

Bring in the threads, cut them short.

Iron the bottom of the neck cape to put in good shape (with a damp cloth if necessary).
