# Poncho « Bambino »

# Size 12/18 months

This work begins by knitting straight ahead, then continues knitted circular.

### Material:

3 skeins of Nebula Artesano, color Stout

Circular needles 5mm, with a 80 cm cable minimum,8 stitch markers

1 row counter, 1 sew needle

### Points and abbreviations:

k: knit

p: purl

M1: make one

M: stitch marker

### Garter stitch:

With straight needles: knit every stitches and every rows.

With circular needles: knit the first round, purl the second one, repeat these 2 rounds.

### Stocking stitch:

With straight needles: Knit the right side row, purl thye wrong side row.

With circular needles: Knit every stitches and every rounds.

Gauge(Stocking stitch, 10cm/10cm):16 st, 23 rows.



#### Work:

Cast on 50 stitches, do 8 rows of garter stitch.

Row 9 (right side row): k3, M, k6, M, k6, M, k7, M, k6, M, k7, M, k6, M, k6, M, k3

Row 10: k3, p6, k6, p7, k6, p7, k6, p6, k3

Row 11: k3, (M1, k6)x2, M1, k7, M1, k6, M1, k7, M1, (k6, M1)x2, k3 (58 stitches)

Row 12: k3, p8, k6, p9, k6, p9, k6, p8, k3

Row 13: k3, M1, k8, M1, k6, M1, k9, M1, k6, M1, k9, M1, k6, M1, k8, M1, k3 (66 stitches)

Row 14: k3, p10, k6, p11, k6, p11, k6, p10, k3

Row 15:k3, M1, k60, M1, k3 (68 stitches)

Row 16: k3, (p11, k6)x3, p11, k3

Row 17: k3, (M1, k11, M1, k6)x3, M1, k11, M1, k3 (76 stitches)

Row 18: Put a marker of stitch at the beginning of the row and close the circle by knitting:

p3, (k13, p6)x3, k13, p3.

#### In circular knitting:

Round 1: k3, (M1, k13, M1, k6)x3, M1, k13, M1, k3 (84 stitches)

Round 2: p3, (k15, p6) x3, k15,p3

Round 3: k3, (M1, k15, M1, k6)x3, M1, k15, M1, k3 (92 stitches)

Round 4: p3, (k17, p6) x3, k17, p3

Round 5: k3, (M1, k17, M1, k6)x3, M1, k17, M1, k3(100 stitches)

Round 6: p3, (k19, p6) x3, k19, p3

Round 7: k3, (M1, k19, M1, k6)x3, M1, k19, M1, k3(108 stitches)

Round 8: p3, (k21, p6) x3, k21, p3

Round 9: k3, M1, k48, M1, k6, M1, k48, M1, k3 (112 stitches)

Round 10: p3, (k22, p6) x3, k22, p3

Round 11: k3, M1, k50, M1, k6, M1, k50, M1, k3(116 stitches)

Round 12: p3, (k23, p6) x3, k23, p3

Round 13: k3, M1, k52, M1, k6, M1, k52, M1, k3 (120 stitches)

Round 14: p3, (k24, p6) x3, k24, p3

Round 15: k3, M1, k54, M1, k6, M1, k54, M1, k3 (124 stitches)

Round 16: p3, (k25, p6) x3, k25, p3

Round 17: k3, M1, k56, M1, k6, M1, k56, M1, k3(128stitches)

Round 18: p3, (k26, p6) x3, k26, p3

Round 19: k3, M1, k58, M1, k6, M1, k58, M1, k3(132stitches)

Round 20: p3, (k27, p6) x3, k27, p3

Round 21: k3, M1, k60, M1, k6, M1, k60, M1, k3 (136stitches)

Round 22: p3, (k28, p6) x3, k28, p3

Chain rounds by keeping this rhythm of increases (4 by round, 1 round on 2) until obtain 204 stitches and approximately total 30 cms in height (since the top of the collar to the bottom of the back or the front, the "sides" where will be arms being a little shorter).

And end by making:

Round 1: k3, M1, k96, M1, k6, M1, k96, M1, k3(208stitches)

Round 2: purl

Round 3: k3, M1, k98, M1, k6, M1, k98, M1, k3 (212stitches)

Round 4: purl

Round 5: k3, M1, k100, M1, k6, M1, k100, M1, k3(216stitches)

Round 6: purl

Round 7: k3, M1, k102, M1, k6, M1, k102, M1,k3(220stitches)

Round 8: purl

Round 9: k3, M1, k104, M1, k6, M1, k104, M1, k3 (224stitches)

Round 10: purl

Round 11: bind off.

Bring in the threads and cut them to short, shape if need.
