The philosophy of the domain:

Since 1893 in the Jarnoterie vineyard, the viticultural tradition has never deviated from their Priority for quality with the weeding, thinning the leaves, sorting the harvest, maturing in chesnut Barrels... The estate's unique objective is to work the whole year to obtain the best —quality grapes, And to then create a quality-top wine. Our leitmotif: Observe, Fell, Wait...to have our terroirs's avours revealed.

Mode of driving of the vineyard, wine-making and ageing :

All year long, a precise and rigorous work is done in each parcel. Partial grass growing, complete grass growing, leaf clipping, green harvest..... A special attention is given to every parcel, always with the same goal: Optimal wine quality and respect of tradition and terroir are the driving forces of "la Jarnoterie". To listen, observe, smell, wait... and reveal the savors of our terroir.... there is our passion. For the entire Domain, the harvest is done mechanically; except for the Cuvée Concerto which is done by hand due to the age of the vines, some 60 to 80 years. At Vignoble de la Jarnoterie the wine tradition never departs with the search for quality. Indeed, a manual selection of the grapes on table is done by 6 to 8 people. So, each grape is ideally selected before it goes into the vat. Next comes the maceration, without air, that will last 10 to 15 days, in order to preserve the maximum "fruit". To finish - all our wines will rest in chestnut barrels, in the cool alcoves of our cellars. Bottling: Aging in a barrel gives us the possibility to get supple and well balanced tannins on each Cuvee... thus giving them a certain elegance and finesse. When the wine gets to is peak, it is "captured" to be bottled.
