

Shawl Frou Frou

Easy, this shawl has a very simple and feminine lace edge

Bicolor, it draws its originality from the game of ruffles.

Materiel :

2 balls of [Mérino Baby Cheval Blanc](#) color 11

1 ball of [Zauberball Stärke 6 Schoppel Wolle](#). Color Route 66

Option 1: Pair of removable circular needles 4mm

2 cables for removable circular needles 100.

2 plugs for cable, wrench.

Option 2: 1 pair of circular needles 4mm on a cable of 100. Wool needle, contrasting thread (about 3m).

Points and abbreviations :

k : knit

p: purl

m1: make one (tutorial there)

SK2P: slip the stitch knitwise, knit 2 stitches together, pass over the slip stitch.

K2tog: knit 2 stitches together

Yo: yarn over

...: Repeat the pattern between * and * as many times as necessary to finish the row or go to the next indication.

(...)x...: Repeat the pattern between (...) as many times as indicated after the "x".

R : row



Picot: Knit a stitch , put it back on the left needle. Insert the right needle between the first two stitches of the left needle. Wrap the thread around the right needle, pull out the loop thus formed and put it in front of the stitches of the left needle. Repeat once. Knit the two "loops" . Bind off a stitch, knit the original stitch of the picot and bind off a stitch. Continue to bind off as indicated by the row. To see how to make a picot image, go to [this page](#):

A: color n°1 ,here Zauberball Stärke 6

B: color n°2, here Mérino Baby color 11.

Work:

Cast on 48 stitches with color A

A R 1: k2, Yo,* k*, 2 stitches before the end of the row: Yo, k2.

A R 2: *k*

B R 3: k2, Yo,* k*, 2 stitches before the end of the row: Yo, k2.

B R 4: k2, *p*, finish with k2.

A R 5: k2, Yo,* k*, 2 stitches before the end of the row: Yo, k2.

A R 6: k2, *p*, finish with k2.

Repeat this section of 4 rows (rows 3 to 6 inclusive), respecting the alternation of the colors until row 16 included.

A R 17: k2, Yo, k2, (m1, k2)x29, Yo, k2.

A R 18: k2, *p*, finish with k2.

B R 19: k2, Yo,* k*, 2 stitches before the end of the row: Yo, k2.

B R 20: k2, *p*, finish with k2.

A R 21: k2, Yo,* k*, 2 stitches before the end of the row: Yo, k2.

A R 22: k2, *p*, finish with k2.

Repeat this section of 4 rows (rows 19 to 22 inclusive), respecting the alternation of the colors until row 52 included.

A R 53: k2, Yo, k2, (m1, k2)x61, k1, Yo, k2.

A R 54: k2, *p*, finish with k2.

B R 55: k2, Yo,* k*, 2 stitches before the end of the row: Yo, k2.

B R 56: k2, *p*, finish with k2.

A R 57: k2, Yo,* k*, 2 stitches before the end of the row: Yo, k2.

A R 58: k2, *p*, finish with k2.

Repeat this section of 4 rows (rows 55 to 58 inclusive), respecting the alternation of the colors until row 92 included.

Option 1 :

Fitting the needles to make the ruffles: this step is not complicated, it requires only a little patience and meticulousness. Tutorial on this page:

When row 92 is finished, put a plug on the end of the needle in place. Retrieve the needle that has just been removed and put it on the second cable, put a plug on the end of this second cable.

Pass this second cable through all the stitches of the row as you progress slowly with the needle. In the end we have two cables passed in the same stitch. The two needles must then be placed on one cable, and the two plugs on the other cable.

Start knit the ruffle 1 with the cable fitted with needles, while the other will be waiting.

Option 2 :

When row 92 is finished, pass the contrast yarn through the stitches of this row with the needle (following the cable of your circular needles), then leave this thread in place so that the stitches can be readily knit the ruffle 2. Start knit the ruffle 1.

Ruffle 1:

This ruffle is knit with color A only, except for the last rows and the row of bidding off.

Note: the pattern in parenthesis corresponds to diagram 1.

R 1, 3 and 5 : k2, Yo,* k*, 2 stitches before the end of the row: Yo, k2.

R 2, and all the wrong side rows : k2, *p*, finish with k2.

R 7: k2, Yo, k4, (k1, Yo, k5, SK2P, k5, Yo)x16, k4, Yo, k2.

R 9: k2, Yo, k5, (k2, Yo, k4, SK2P, k4, Yo, k1)x16, k5, Yo, k2.

R 11: k2, Yo, k6, (k3, Yo, k3, SK2P, k3, Yo, k2)x16, k6, Yo, k2.

R 13: k2, Yo, k7, (k4, Yo, k2, SK2P, k2, Yo, k3)x16, k7, Yo, k2.

R 15: k2, Yo, k8, (k5, Yo, k1, SK2P, k1, Yo, k4)x16, k8, Yo, k2.

R 17: k2, Yo, k9, (k6, Yo, SK2P, Yo, k5)x16, k9, Yo, k2.

R 19: k2, Yo, k3, (k1, Yo, k5, SK2P, k5, Yo)x17, k3, Yo, k2.

R 21: k2, Yo, k4, (k2, Yo, k4, SK2P, k4, Yo, k1)x17, k4, Yo, k2.

R 23: k2, Yo, k5, (k3, Yo, k3, SK2P, k3, Yo, k2)x17, k5, Yo, k2.

R 25: k2, Yo, k6, (k4, Yo, k2, SK2P, k2, Yo, k3)x17, k6, Yo, k2.

R 27: k2, Yo, k7, (k5, Yo, k1, SK2P, k1, Yo, k4)x17, k7, Yo, k2..

R 29: k2, Yo, k8, (k6, Yo, SK2P, Yo, k5)x18, k8, Yo, k2.

R 31: k2, Yo, k2, (k1, Yo, k5, SK2P, k5, Yo)x18, k2, Yo, k2.

R 33: k2, Yo, k3, (k2, Yo, k4, SK2P, k4, Yo, k1)x18, k3, Yo, k2.

R 35: k2, Yo, k4, (k3, Yo, k3, SK2P, k3, Yo, k2)x18, k4, Yo, k2.

R 37: k2, Yo, k5, (k4, Yo, k2, SK2P, k2, Yo, k3)x18, k5, Yo, k2.

R 39: k2, Yo, k6, (k5, Yo, k1, SK2P, k1, Yo, k4)x18, k6, Yo, k2.

R 41: k2, Yo, k7, (k6, Yo, SK2P, Yo, k5)x18, k7, Yo, k2.

R 43: k2, Yo, k1, (k1, Yo, k5, SK2P, k5, Yo)x19, k1, Yo, k2.

R 45: k2, Yo, k2, (k2, Yo, k4, SK2P, k4, Yo, k1)x19, k2, Yo, k2.

R 47: k2, Yo, k3, (k3, Yo, k3, SK2P, k3, Yo, k2)x19, k3, Yo, k2.

R 49: k2, Yo, k4, (k4, Yo, k2, SK2P, k2, Yo, k3)x19, k4, Yo, k2.

R 51: k2, Yo, k5, (k5, Yo, k1, SK2P, k1, Yo, k4)x19, k5, Yo, k2.

R 53: k2, Yo, k6, (k6, Yo, SK2P, Yo, k5)x19, k6, Yo, k2.

R 55 : k2, Yo, k14, Yo, k1, (Yo, k13, Yo, k1)x18, Yo, k14, Yo, k2.

B R 57: k2, Yo, *k* finish with Yo, k2.

B R 58: *k*

B R 59: Cast off all sts loosely around the row with approx. 8 stitches (except for the first stitches and the last stitches of the ruffle, choose 9 sts), in the center of the triangle of the pattern that formed and at the top of the "leaf" of the pattern.

Ruffle 2 : knit it with color B

Note: the pattern in parenthesis corresponds to diagram 2.

With option 1, put the needles in place of the plugs on the cable, and start knitting. With option 2, lift stitches and start knitting.

R 1 : k2, Yo, k3, (k1, Yo, k3, SK2P, k3, Yo)x22, k3, Yo, k2.

R 2 and all wrong side rows : k2, *p*, finish with k2.

R 3: k2, Yo, k4, (k2, Yo, k2, SK2P, k2, Yo, k1)x22, k4, Yo, k2.

R 5: k2, Yo, k5, (k3, Yo, k1, SK2P, k1, Yo, k2)x22, k5, Yo, k2.

R 7: k2, Yo, k6, (k4, Yo, SK2P, Yo, k3)x22, k6, Yo, k2.

R 9: k2, Yo, k2, (k1, Yo, k3, SK2P, k3, Yo)x23, k2, Yo, k2.

R 11: k2, Yo, k3, (k2, Yo, k2, SK2P, k2, Yo, k1)x23, k3, Yo, k2.

R 13: k2, Yo, k4, (k3, Yo, k1, SK2P, k1, Yo, k2)x23, k4, Yo, k2.

R 15: k2, Yo, k5, (k4, Yo, SK2P, Yo, k3)x23, k5, Yo, k2.

R 17: k2, Yo, (K2tog, Yo)x2, SK2P, *(Yo, K2tog)x2, Yo, k1,* 12 stitches before the end of the row, finish with: (Yo, K2tog)x5, Yo, k2.

R19: bind off 7 stitches, * picot, bind off 6 stitches *, finish with picot and bind off the 7 last stitches.

Wash and block the shawl in a half circle, first block the ruffle 1, then the ruffle 2, putting your needles on the picots. When it is dry, bring in the threads and cut them short.

Shawl Frou Frou, number of stitches per row: body of striped shawl.
