



Pattern of the little gilet for a little baby girl  
(premie/newborn)



**Fournitures :**

1 skein of Phil Cotton 3 de Phildar  
Circular or long straight needles 3 mm  
hook 3 mm

**Final dimensions :**

20 cm from bottom to up  
24 cm large at the bottom  
(19 cm large under the shoulders)

**Gauge :**

26 stitches/35 rows in 4"

**Ready ? Go !**

- Cast on loosely 112 stitches (the gilet is started from bottom)
- row 1 : purl
- row 2: k1,\*K2tog, 1 yo\* repeat until you have 3 stitches, k2tog, K1
- row 3 to 4 : purl
- row 5 : knit
- row 6 : purl
- row 7 : k2,\*k9,k2tog\* repeat 9 times, k11
- row 8 : purl
- row 9 : knit
- row 10 to 12 : purl
- row 13 : knit
- row 14 : purl
- row 15 : k2,\*k8,k2tog\* repeat 9 times, k11
- row 16 : purl
- row 17 : knit
- row 18 to 20 : purl
- row 21 : knit
- row 22 : purl
- row 23 : k3,\*k7,k2tog\* repeat 9 times, k3
- row 24 : purl
- row 25 : knit
- row 26 to 28 : purl
- row 29: knit
- row 30 : purl
- row 31 : k2,\*k6,k2tog\* repeat 9 times, k3
- row 32 : purl

- row 33 : knit
  - row 34 : purl
  - row 35 to 41 : knit
- You have 74 stitches.

**Now we are beginning the decreases and separating back with armholes creation.**

- row 42 : knit 15 st, cast off 4 st, knit 36 st, cast off 4 st, knit 15 st.

Put the first 15 stitches and the 36 stitches on a separate needle.

On the 15 last stitches (you begin on wrong side, all is in garter stitches):

- row 1 to 4 : skp, knit
- row 5 : skp, knit
- row 6 : knit
- row 7 to 16 : repeat 6 times rows 5 and 6
- row 17 to 18 : knit
- row 19 to 20 : repeat rows 5 and 6
- knit until you have 20 cm from bottom of the gilet, or longer, as you want it !

**Take the 15 other stitches and knit the other side of the gilet.**

- row 1 to 4 : skp, knit
- row 5 : knit
- row 6 : skp, knit
- row 7 to 16 : repeat 6 times rows 5 and 6
- row 17 to 18 : knit
- row 19 to 20 : repeat rows 5 and 6
- knit until you have 20 cm from bottom of the gilet, or longer, as you want it !

**Now you have to knit the 36 stitches back.**

- row 1 to 4 : skp, knit
- knit until you have 19,5 cm from bottom of the gilet, or longer
- knit 6 stitches, turn, cast off the 6 stitches, and continue to cast off until you have 6 stitches on your left needle. Knit the 6 stitches, turn and cast off them.

**Ending the gilet :**

- sew the shoulders to the back
- take hook 3 mm and do the border. Begin on a bottom side. Draw through. Make single crochet stitches until the bottom of the other side. Turn. Make double crochet stitches until the bottom of the other side. Add shells on both sides (front).
- With the hook, make 2 chains of 40 stitches on both sides to close the gilet.
